THE COURT MADE THE FOLLOWING:

ORDER

This petition is filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. by accused Nos.1 to 7 in Cr.No.65/2023 of Doddapete police station registered for the offences punishable under Sections 399 and 402 IPC and Section 25 (1)(a) of Indian Arms Act, 1959.

2. It is submitted by the learned counsel for petitioners that petitioners-1 and 5 / accused Nos.1 to 5 are already enlarged on statutory bail by the learned Magistrate and therefore, insofar as the said petitioners are concerned, the petition has become infructuous.

3. It is alleged in the complaint lodged by the PSI of Thunganagara police station that he received a credible information on 15.02.2023 at about 7.00 p.m. that few CRL.P No. 3303 of 2023 persons are making preparation to commit dacoity and as such he went to Room No.25 of Pallavi Tourist Lodge situated at A.A.Circle, Shivamogga and apprehended accused Nos.1 to 5, who were conspiring to commit dacoity by stopping the vehicle plying on Shivamogga-Gajanur road. Weapons and chilli powder were seized from their possession.

4. Insofar as petitioners-6 and 7 are concerned, they were arrested on 17.02.2023. It appears that their names came to be revealed by accused Nos.1 to 5. Except the voluntary statement of accused Nos.1 to 5, at this stage there are no sufficient material against the petitioners. It is submitted that from the possession of the petitioners no incriminating articles are recovered. Hence, the following:

ORDER i. Petition is allowed in part.

CRL.P No. 3303 of 2023 ii. Petition in respect of petitioners.1 to 5/accused Nos.1 to 5 is dismissed as having become infructuous.

iii. Petition is allowed in respect of petitioners-6 and 7/accused Nos.6 and 7.

iv. Petitioners-6 and 7/accused Nos.6 and 7 shall be enlarged on bail in Cr.No.65/2023 of Doddapete Police station, Shivamogga, subject to following conditions:

ii. Petitioners shall furnish proof of their residential address and shall inform the Investigating Officer/Court, if there is any change in the address.

- iii. Petitioners shall not directly or indirectly tamper with the prosecution witnesses.
- iv. Petitioners shall not indulge themselves in committing any offence.
- v. Petitioners shall appear before the Trial Court regularly.
